COVID-19 UPDATE – LINCOLN COUNTY, NC

Lincolnton, NC -

The following counts are based on data reported to the Lincoln County Health Department as of today:

A PUI is a person who was tested for COVID-19 and is self-isolating until results are received.

EMERGING COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS REGARDING REINFECTION RATES

- Reinfection is highly unlikely once recovered, but some evidence does support the notion that reinfection is possible in some situations.
- According to early data, antibodies developed by COVID-19 infection are considered protective against reinfection for up to 3 months after initial recovery.
- At this time, there is not enough information available to determine the degree of immunity beyond 3 months.

REMEMBER THE "3 W's" AND REDUCE YOUR RISK OF EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

WEAR a cloth face covering, WAIT in lines 6 feet apart, and WASH your hands often.
