## **COVID-19 VACCINE APPOINTMENT UPDATE – LINCOLN COUNTY, NC**

Lincolnton, NC – The Lincoln County Health Department will offer open scheduling for first dose COVID-19 vaccines to individuals in Groups 1-3 ([Priority Groups](#)) next week. Appointments will be on Thursday, March 18<sup>th</sup> and Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup>. As vaccine supply continues to remain low, there will be a limited number of appointments made available.

The health department will use an online appointment system for the Thursday and Friday slots for appointments next week. Anyone with an appointment will be asked to bring in a print out of their appointment confirmation or proper identification. For people in the eligible priority group that do not have the means for online scheduling, the health department will reserve an allocation that can be made by phone at 704-736-2206.

The appointment slots will be made available online Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup> at 9am EST.
